EVENT: Museum Pass Program

The Friends of the Clifton Park-Halfmoon Public Library have added a new Museum to their Museum Pass Program. The National Racing Museum and Hall of Fame is now added to the seven other museums in this program.

The National Racing Museum and Hall of Fame pass will allow for up to four people into the Museum for free. This pass also includes a 50% discount on the Backstretch Tours and a 15% discount in the Museum Gift Shop.

Library Cardholders who live in the Library District and are 18 years of age or older may now check out membership museum passes for eight museums at no cost. The passes will be loaned out for 3 days, and on a first come-first serve basis. Passes may not be reserved in advance.
