



## The Butterfly Project

The Two Towns – One Book encourages you to read *The Butterfly* by Patricia Polacco and *The Book Thief* by Markus Zusak, join the community conversation, and participate with us in The Butterfly Project.

1,500,000 innocent children perished in the Holocaust. In an effort to remember them, Holocaust Museum Houston is collecting 1.5 million handmade butterflies.

The butterflies will eventually comprise a breath-taking exhibition.

We encourage you to create one or more handmade arts-and-crafts butterflies. This project may be completed by all ages as individuals or groups.

- Butterflies should be no larger than 8 inches by 10 inches.
- Butterflies may be of any medium the artist chooses, but two-dimensional submissions are preferred.
- Glitter and all glitter-related products should **not** be used.
- Food products (cereal, macaroni, candy, marshmallows or other perishables) also should not be used.
